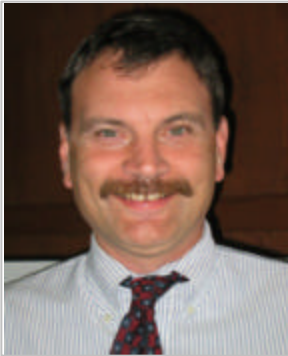


GREGORY C. JONES, ASLA
